Alexander Jordan Mork, 29, a beloved grandson, brother, nephew, cousin, and friend, was unexpectedly called home to be with his Lord, joining his mother and brother on February 10, 2025.

Alex was born on March 4, 1995, in Racine, WI to Erin (Mork) Price. He was the eldest cousin in the family and was looked up to and adored by the younger cousins. Alex was “always there,” making the effort to be at every family function and get together. He always made sure to give everyone a hug when he arrived and another one when he left.

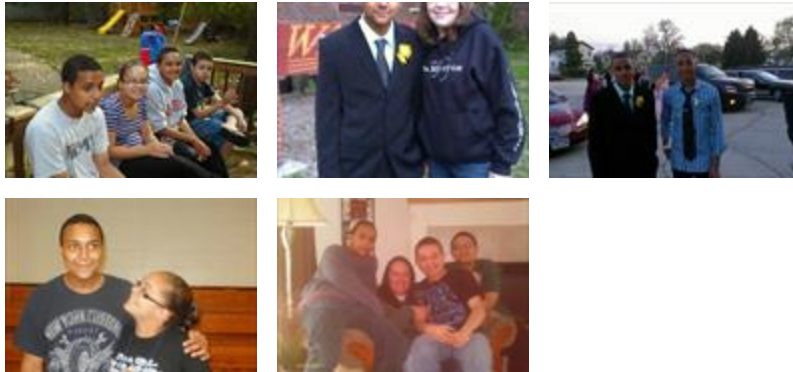
