RACINE-Anina Cathrine Jacobsen, 94, passed away at Wheaton Franciscan Health Care-All Saints on Thursday February 24, 2011. Anina was born in Superior, Nebraska the daughter of the late Nels and Marie (nee: Gregersen) Svendsen on April 12, 1916. She was raised on a farm near Superior, Nebraska and was baptized, confirmed and married at Bethany Lutheran Church in Ruskin, Nebraska, moving to Racine after graduating from high school in Superior. Anina was united in marriage to Lawrence Jacobsen on October 4, 1938 in Ruskin, Nebraska. She was a member of Lutheran Church of the Resurrection for 73 years. Anina was very active in Ladies Aid, church choir and bible study. She taught Sunday school for 45 years, and could often be found organizing and serving funeral luncheons in the fellowship hall at church. Anina found great enjoyment in sewing, knitting and crocheting for her family and friends and could often be found enjoying a good story about real people in books, "The Capers Weekly", Guide Post, and Readers Digest. Most of all she took great pride in helping to sew quilts for Lutheran World Relief and habitat for humanity and making and serving meals for needy families at St. Patrick's Catholic Church.
