On March 31, 1947, Ava was united in marriage to Adam Sedlak in a little church in Las Vegas, NV. Moving to Milwaukee after their marriage and later moving to Racine. Before marriage and raising a family, Ava's working career began at Ryan Aircraft in San Diego, CA, then Pabst Brewing Company in Milwaukee. Ava was a member of First Baptist Church in Oak Creek. She did clerical work for many companies over the years, but settled in as a homemaker, where she enjoyed taking care of her family. Ava also survived open heart surgery in 1961. After Adam's retirement in 1980 they moved to Salmon, Idaho, living there for 30 years. They later returned to Racine to be closer to her daughter. A talented musician, she loved playing various instruments, including guitar, violin, piano, organ, accordion and the harmonica. Enjoyed listening to music especially hymns. She was a loving wife and mother. Ava's love of the Lord was apparent in her positive attitude, always willing to lend an ear and ever willing to share her quotes "It will get better" or maybe "If you can't say anything good, don't say anything at all." She also enjoyed flower gardening, cooking, and loved her cats.

Ava is survived by her daughter, Sharon (Brian) Kubowski, nephew, Dan

(Denise) Schnabel Jr.; great nephews, Grant and Derek Schnabel, great niece, Althea Reetz, nephew, Steven Sedlak and cousin, Richard Noland. Ava is further survived by other relatives and friends.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Adam on July 15, 2011 and brothers, Doyle, James, and Lowell Current.
