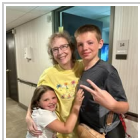
Private funeral services have been held. Memorials to Valley of the Kings Sanctuary & Retreat (VotK.org) or Faithbridge Church have been suggested.

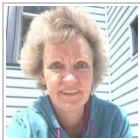
