RACINE-Bruce John McIntosh, 66, passed away at All Saints, surrounded by his loving family on Friday, March 28, 2014. He served in the United States Navy from 1966 to 1973, serving two tours in Vietnam. Bruce graduated from Park High School in 1965 and received a degree in accounting from U.W. Parkside in 1980. He was a co-owner of a local machine shop, Yumac, Inc. Bruce enjoyed spending time and fishing at the family trailer on Army Lake. Most of all, he loved bowling and playing sheephead with his buddies.

Surviving are his wife, Barb; daughters, Lisa and Heidi; grandchildren, Haley, Natalie, Nathan; siblings, Daniel (Janet), Gordon (MaryAnne) and Andrew (Gail) McIntosh, Susan (Eric) Wentorf and Anna (Joey) LeGath. He is further survived by many nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends.
