FRANKSVILLE-Burton Roy Brewer, 101, passed away at WFH-All Saints on January 22, 2016. He was born in Racine on March 21, 1914 the son of the late Frederick and Ann (nee: Hughes) Brewer. Burton was united in marriage to Henrietta C. Christenson on January 18, 1936. He was employed as a machinist at Hamilton Beach for 17 years, Gorton Machine Co. for 22 years and Lars Machine for three years, retiring in 1978. For 33 years he also did hand engraving for family, friends and numerous businesses throughout the area. Burton was noted for his many pen and ink drawings of famous cathedrals featuring chimes and clocks. He found great enjoyment in model railroading and built an intricate train layout in his basement. Burton also enjoyed genealogy research, photography, and gardening. He and his wife Henrietta collected elephant figurines of all sorts and sizes.

Burton is survived by his children: Dennis of Franksville, JoEtta Doolittle of Wells, Minn; three daughters-in-law, Sharon, Susan and AeCha Brewer. He is further survived by eight grandchildren, five step-grandchildren, 18 great grandchildren, and six step-great grandchildren, one great great granddaughter and three step-great great grandchildren.

Burton was preceded in death by his wife of 50 years, Henrietta on June 27, 1986; three sons, Bruce, Robert and Richard; one granddaughter, Deborah Kopf and one great great granddaughter, Hailyn Brewer.

Wednesday January 27, 2016 at 1:30 pm. with Rev. Dr. Patrick Schultz officiating. Visitation will be held at church on Wednesday from 12 noon until service time at 1:30 pm. He will be laid to rest next to his wife at West Lawn Memorial Park following the service.

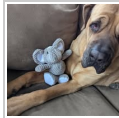

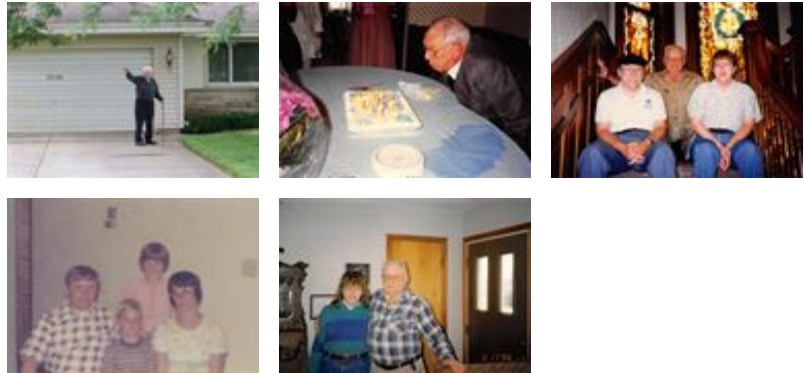
