RACINE – Clayton V. Janney, 93, passed away peacefully with his family by his side on Tuesday, January 20, 2015 at the Wisconsin Veterans Home in Union Grove. He was born in Richland Center on August 5, 1921, the son of the late Vivian and Maude (nee: Hooper) Janney. On June 1, 1946, Clayton was united in marriage to Bernardine Krueger in Forest Park, IL. He proudly served in the United States Army during World War II in the 82nd Airborne Division, receiving a Purple Heart and two Bronze Battle Stars. Clayton was a member of St. Lucy's Catholic Church and the Disabled American Veterans. Surviving are his children, Clayton (Joan) Janney, Mary-Michael (Dan) Weilandt, Gerard (Nancy) Janney, Jeannine (Dr. Steve) Pagano, Bernard (Amy) Janney, Peter (Aydee) Janney, Lori (Jim) Kleifgen and Peggy (Jim) Chiumiento, son-in-law, Paul Dubovik; tons of grandchildren and great-grandchildren and his loving sister, Arlene Heinzelman.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Bernardine, daughter, Barbara Dubovik, son, Michael Janney and great grandson, Jeremiah Dubovik.
