RACINE – Cora M. (nee: Lehmann) Potterville, 102, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, November 19, 2014 at Becker Shoop Rehab. Center. Cora was born in Baraboo, WI on January 21, 1912, the daughter of the late William and Meta (nee: Rump) Lehmann. She was united in marriage to Arthur Potterville at on September 29, 1934 at St. John's Lutheran Church in Baraboo. They moved to Racine that same year. Cora had been employed at Multi-Products as an assembler, retiring on December 22, 1982 after 20 years of service. She was a longtime member of Emmanuel Lutheran Church. Cora served as past commander and retained a life membership in the Navy Mother's Club and Disabled American Veterans. She attended St. Paul's Church Neighborhood Center presently known as Racine Senior Center. Cora loved to play cards and crocheted many afghans for her family. She also was a great baker, especially enjoyed making cookies.

Surviving are her children, Eugene (Doris) Potterville of Racine and Shirley (Buddy) Ferrell of Milltown, IN; seven grandchildren, nine great grandchildren and twelve great great grandchildren. She if further survived by nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends.

Cora was preceded in death by her husband, Arthur on September 11, 1954, son and daughter-in-law, Arthur (Marge) Potterville of Boise, Idaho and eleven brothers and sisters.

Funeral services will be held at Emmanuel Lutheran Church, 725 High St. on

Monday, November 24, 2014 at 11 a.m. with Rev. John Bischoff officiating. She will be laid to rest at Graceland Cemetery. There will be a visitation at the church on Monday before services, from 9:30 a.m. until time of service at 11 a.m.
