Dale R. Nielsen

RACINE-Dale R. Nielsen, age 61, was born in Racine on December 12, 1953 and passed away November 7th, 2015 after a courageous battle with stage IV colon cancer. Although the cancer attacked his body it could not touch his spirit. His will to live sent him on stoic 2 ½ year battle. He never played the cancer card, never complained about treatment and proved what an exceptional person he was.

He was a lifelong resident of Racine, the son of Clayton H. and Irene G. (nee: Chapas) Nielsen. He attended McKinley elementary and middle school and graduated from Horlick High School in 1972. Before college he worked at his father's company, Nielsen Iron works in Racine. Dale then graduated from UW-Oshkosh in 1977 with a degree in Business Administration and a minor in Human Resources. After college graduation he was a project manager at Nielsen's building Northwest Mutual Life in Downtown Milwaukee. In 1984, his father, brothers and Tom Johnson formed Nielsen Building Systems, an architectural design-build firm. Dale then began selling architectural products and became the Wisconsin Distributor for Kalwall, a translucent wall panel. He built many signature projects that many would be familiar with: The atrium skylight at the Milwaukee Airport, the curved arch entry skylights to many Aurora Health Care medical centers, the Olympic training facility at Northern Michigan University, and the translucent panels and opening outfield walls at Miller Park in Milwaukee.

At Oshkosh he met his wife Beth Hartman, also from Racine and they married in 1980. Together they raised two wonderful children, Christo and Erica.

Dale is survived by his loving wife Beth (Hartman) of 35 years, son Christo Nielsen and daughter, Erica (Caleb) Butler all of Racine; grandsons, Logan Fesko, Charles and Brady Butler, brother Jim Nielsen and sister-in-law Sandi Nielsen. He is further survived by five nephews and a niece, other relatives and many dear friends.

He is preceded in death by his parents, Clayton and Irene, brother Bruce and mother-in-law Charlotte Hartman.

Dale was a member of Covenant Presbyterian Church, 5th Street Yacht Club and Salmon Unlimited and enjoyed spending time on his boat on Lake Michigan. During his illness the family would reminisce about how much fun they had on vacations together, family events and football games, to name a few. Dale's love of the outdoors led to many adventures: snow skiing, scuba diving, sailing, boating and fishing (where he always caught his limit), and especially his time at the cottage in the North Woods. Dale was a lot of fun, whether telling jokes or hilarious stories (usually about himself), spending time with family, friends and making new friends wherever he went. As Dale would say "It really was A Wonderful Life".

I first met Dale in the late 70's, just after we hired Nielsen Iron Works to be our Kalwall distributor for Wisconsin. His father Clay had said 'I want you to meet my youngest son, Dale. He likes people, is fun, smart, just got out of college with a Business degree and I'm sure he can sell your Kalwall.'

Clay was right--could he ever. Dale was a natural-born salesman. Over 25 years, we sold a ton of Kalwall, including the Miller Ballpark project. And along the way a really good thing happened--he became my friend.

My mind is full of wonderful memories--I'll only mention a few. We would go on sales calls in his super-long Thunderbird, a car with doors so large they would hit the next county if you opened them wide. We'd talk about our girls, his Beth, who he would soon marry, and my Rene, whom I had just married. We four toured San Francisco later and had a ball.

Dale was smart and earned many Kalwall awards for outstanding sales. He early learned the power of computers and used it to help NBS grow. His print-outs were a thing of beauty, and that was when paper edges still had holes. Jan his new girl-Friday, would help. What an angel she was--her glue held the Nielsen clan together for years.

As Nielsen Bldg. Systems, grew, so did Dale's sales force. I remember the time Bill Kyle and I went to the upper peninsula in Bruce's old Oldsmobile and got caught in a snowstorm near Houghton. The car wouldn't go, we couldn't go--Dale said stay, sleep well, have a brandy on me. That's Dale--always generous--buying you a drink no matter where you were.

I came to respect Dale more and more over the years as he grew, NBS grew and his family grew. The love of Beth, Christo and Erica was obvious. One day, with a glint in his eye, Dale told me that the true measure of love is how excited your dog gets when you come home. And if you ever watched Dale enter his home you knew he was right.

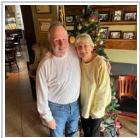
