Debra 'Debbie' (Fier) Adams, 54, passed away on Friday, March 4, 2016 at Froedtert Hospital in Milwaukee after a brief battle with leukemia. 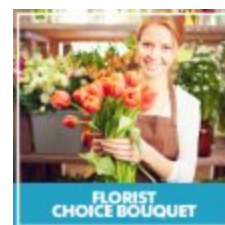
