RACINE – Edward J. Micnovicz, 90, passed away on Friday, December 16, 2016.

He was born on the family farm in Caledonia on July, 18, 1926 to the late Victor and Antonia (nee: Ptak) Micnovicz. Ed attended St. Rita Elementary School, Washington Jr. High and was a 1944 graduate of Wm. Horlick High School. The industrial arts teacher, Mr. Sorenson, hired Ed to work on Saturdays to teach a class of girls to run machines for the war effort. Ed said that was a lot of fun. He served in the United States Army and fought in the Battle of the Philippine Sea and was a member of the first unit to occupy Japan. He worked as a tool and die maker for Young Radiator for 47 years. On September 17, 1949 Ed was united in marriage to Patricia Essmus at St. Patrick's Catholic Church.

Ed was an avid fisherman and deer hunter. He always looked forward to deer hunting in Kennan Wisconsin and the Wind Point Jetties for smelt fishing.

Ed is survived by his wife of 67 years, Pat, two children, Tom (Debi) Micnovicz of Racine and Terri (Tom) Garcia of Rio Rancho, NM; four grandchildren, Craig (Chrissy) of Racine, Amy (Kevin) of Milwaukee, Beth (Jhony) Desai of Racine and Elliott Garcia of Madison; five great grandchildren, Cypress, Covin, Carson, Jason and Aryan, all of Racine. He is further survived by nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends.
