Elaine skipped a grade in high school and graduated from Horlick at 16. She attended 'Normal School' for teaching and 14 months later she taught at Fritchen which was a one room country school with all 8 grades. She did this for two years. She then was at Rapids School as the principal and taught 5th-8th grades. She then taught 3rd grade at Fratt School as a unit leader. Elaine was the 1st female principal in Racine at Winslow School. She also was a national consultant for the University of Wisconsin in Madison. She then went on to be an assistant superintendent of schools in Milton, Wisconsin.

All this time she constantly went back to school to get her bachelors, masters and

credits towards her doctorate. She loved education so much she worked as a substitute principal until she was 87 at Racine Unified. After her reluctant retirement she became the "Lunch Lady" at Racine Christian School. During her life she was also a travel agent and she worked for H & R Block. She will always be known for never wanting to spend money on herself because she was always extremely generous with her family, treating us to many vacations. She was happiest when surrounded by all her family. She was preceded in death by her parents Nick and Alida Sarto, and her sisters Dorothy Van Bree and Dr. Gloria Sarto. Her 1st husband of 25 years, was Don McGregor, and her second husband of 25 years was Carl Weber. Survivors are her two daughters, Cindy (Steve) Miley, and Debbie (Ric) Palmer.
