CHANDLER ARIZONA-Ella Cariello, 92, formerly of Racine, went to meet Jesus Christ her Lord and Savior on Sunday October 23, 2011. Ella was born in Edmonton, Alberta Canada to Albert and Anna (Selky) Kremin. With her parents and sister Dorothy, they moved to Racine in 1922.

On June 1, 1936 Ella married her childhood sweetheart, Joseph in the "First Bride and Groom of June" contest (and won) sponsored by the Journal Times. They had celebrated 70 years of marriage before his passing on June 25, 2006. Ella was educated in the schools of Racine where she received her education in bookkeeping and accounting. In her young adult life she worked for Matranga Grocery, Hamilton Beach and Osters. Using her skills in bookkeeping she worked for Rajo Motors, R&B Grinding and for over 30 years for Boscha Builders retiring at the age of 81.
