RACINE – Ella (nee: Andersen) Hearn, 89, passed away on Wednesday, August 15, 2012, at Ridgewood Care Center. She was born in Klejtrup, Denmark on December 27, 1922, the daughter of the late John and Elsie (nee: Nielsen) Andersen. Ella was a graduate of William Horlick High School 'Class of 1940'.
