



## Florence Mae Anderson

October 3, 1931 - November 21, 2021

Miss Florence Mae Anderson, 90, resident of Racine, went home to be with her Lord and Savior on November 21, 2021.

A lifetime resident of Racine, she was born on October 3, 1931, to Elmer and Florence Anderson. After graduating from Washington Park High School in 1949, Florence worked for eight years as the Advertising department Secretary at Massey-Harris. For the next 34-1/2 years she worked at SC Johnson as an Administrative Secretary. She was a member of the company's 20 & 30- year Club and retired from Johnson's December 31, 1991.

Florence was an active member of Racine Bible Church, where for over 50 years she served as Sunday School teacher, choir member and secretary, editor of RENEWAL - the monthly church paper, visitor information desk coordinator, and a church Phoebe. For many years she also served as the organist for the mid-week evening services, along with Jim Hay, a great pianist!

She was preceded in death by her parents; her brothers, Elmer A. Anderson and William A. Anderson; and her niece, Billie Severign Anderson; her sisters, Violet Adelle Newman and Marie Aline Venne.

She is survived by a brother-in-law, Eric Newman of Bradenton, FL., as well as several nieces and nephews and their children.

Further surviving are two special RBC families that "adopted" her as their "aunt": David and Lin Yen Lee and their children, Lawrence, and Emily; and Elizabeth and Steve Miller and their children, Daniel, Stephanie, and Peter.

She was also abundantly blessed with the friendship and love of Luke, Noelle, Taryn, Julia, and Joel Bowers, as well as their parents- - Pastor Darien and Libby Bowers of RBC. Florence was especially grateful for the Christian love and help extended to her over the years by these families, as well as from Jan and Kurt Wahlen. By bringing such special friends as Judy and John Anderson of Racine Bible Church into her life, the Lord ever lovingly oversaw for her care and needs as she became older. She is also survived by many other special friends - both young and old - from a loving RBC family.

Services will be held at Racine Bible Church, 12505 Spring St, Sturtevant, WI on December 2, 2021. Visitation will be held at the church from 4:00 - 5:30 followed by memorial service and fellowship meal. Florence will be laid to rest in a private ceremony at West lawn Cemetery.
