



Rev. Francisco Javier Golon Godoy

December 23, 1950 - June 22, 2020

MOUNT PLEASANT - Rev. Francisco Javier Golon Godoy, 69, passed away at his residence on Monday, June 22, 2020. He was born in Tiquisate, Guatemala on December 23, 1950, the son of Alejandro and Pilar (nee: Valiente) Golon. He was united in marriage to Noemi Leiva Golon in Guatemala City on September 30, 1976.

Francisco served in the Guatemalan Armed Forces as an Electrical Specialist from May of 1979 until June 1985. He was a graduate of Theological Education. His ministry began as a Church Planter for the Hispanic Ministries in Buena Park, Anaheim, and Artesia CA where he was a member and minister of the Christian Reformed Churches. Moving to Racine in 2007, he was a member and served at Racine and Kenosha Christian Reformed Churches and originated La Gran Comision Hispanic Ministries until his retirement this February of 2020.

Surviving is his wife of 43 years, Noemi; sons, Master Sergeant Francisco Otoniel Golon of Monterey, CA, and Elmer Gamaliel Golon of Racine and daughter, Rebecca (David) Golon Santiago of Anaheim, CA, grandchildren; Skyler, Sage, Felecia and Oliver, brother Juan Godoy and sister, Raquel Golon. He is further survived by several nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends.
