KENOSHA-Frankie Joseph Giampietro, 18, passed away peacefully in his sleep at his residence on May 30, 2013. He was a graduate of Tremper High School "Class of 2012", was active with the marketing club and participated in summer marching bands, K-L through Band of the Black Watch. During his years of education, Frankie earned placement in National Junior Honor Society while attending Lincoln Middle School and was a proud member of the UWM non major band. His diligent work earned him being placed on The Dean's list his first semester at The University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee. He found great enjoyment in his music and the many instruments he played, ranging from alto and tenor saxophone, guitar, piano, drums and bass.
