RACINE - George Alfonse "Judd" De Pelecyn, 97, passed away at Ascension All Saints on Thursday, October 26, 2017.

He was born in Belgium on September 12, 1920, the son of the late Cyril and Clothilda (nee: Vertenta) De Pelecyn. On September 27, 1941, George was united in marriage to June Fredrickson. He proudly served in the United States Army in WWII, serving in the 48th Tank and 14th Armored Division. Judd was employed by Advance Transportation for 43 years.

He was a long time member of Living Faith Lutheran Church, formally Atonement Lutheran Church, and Disabled American Veterans. Judd also enjoyed being a member of Johnson Park Senior Golf Club, Castle Lane Senior Men's Bowling Club and Regency Walker's Club.

Surviving are his sons, Gary De Pelecyn and Randy (Mindy Hoover) De Pelecyn; grandchildren, Amy, Julie (Mike), and Cari; great grandchildren, Gregory, Alyssa, Hailey and sister, Irene Letsch. Judd is further survived by his daughter-in-law, Jane De Pelecyn, special friend and caregiver, Rebecca Petit, other relatives and friends.

He was preceded in death by his wife of 74 years, June on January 5, 2016 and brother, William De Pelecyn
