FRANKSVILLE - Hedwig 'Hattie' Anna Schuppe, 101, passed away on Thursday, July 6, 2017 at Ridgewood Care Center.

She was born on December 25, 1915 in Morrowville, KS, the daughter of the late Karl and Theresa Mueller. On October 10, 1936, Hattie was united in marriage to George Schuppe, Jr at St. Louis Parish in Caledonia.

Hattie worked as a pants presser for many years at dry cleaner in Caledonia and Racine. She was a member of St. Louis Parish, belonged to a bowling league in her younger years, and enjoyed playing Sheepshead. She also enjoyed going to Minocqua with her family, and then with couples that George worked with. Hattie also loved to bake. No one could come close to the lemon pies that she would make, and her German potato salad was just as good.

Hattie had a knack for rescuing stray cats and a dog, Mitzi.

Surviving are her daughter, Joanne (Gene) Linley and Catherine Peters, and grandson, Jeff.

Hattie was preceded in death by her husband, George on December 6, 1985, two brothers, two sisters, and her son-in-law.

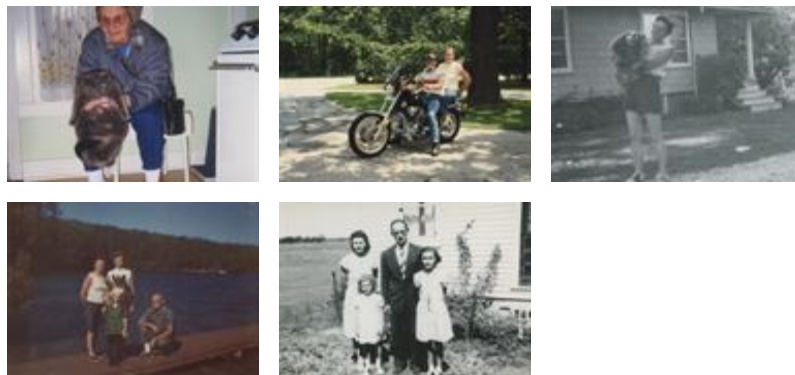

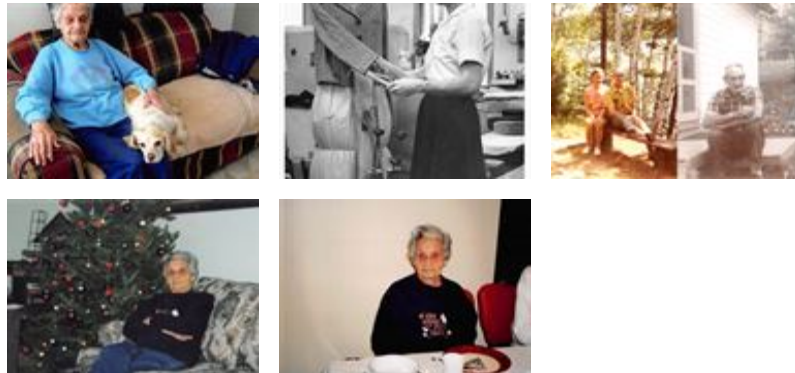
