



## Helene Kant

July 30, 1922 - August 6, 2017

RACINE - Helene Kant, age 95, passed away on Sunday, August 6, 2017 with her family by her side.

Helene was born on July 30, 1922 in Romanov, Kreis Luzk, Poland (a German colony) to Gustav and Berta (nee Guenther) Friedrich. On Oct. 30, 1943 in Schommeln, Germany, she was united in marriage to Emanuel Kant. They lived in Vechta and Oldenburg, Germany until immigrating to the United States in 1952 and settling in Kenosha, WI.

Helene was employed in 1952 by American Motors Corp. in Kenosha. After a few years she became a full-time homemaker. She helped her husband with his secondary business repairing cars by actively attending auctions and bidding on cars. The family also raised chickens and sheep on their property in Pleasant Prairie, WI. Helene moved to Racine from Kenosha in 2003 in order to be closer to family, after the death of Emanuel on May 10, 2001. She had a green thumb and enjoyed growing flowers and plants that she would sell or donate for fund-raisers. She also enjoyed collecting dolls, visiting yard sales, and baking. She had attended the First Church of God in Kenosha and upon moving to Racine, attended Racine First Church of God on Lathrop Avenue. She was a gentle and kind person that loved God and her family. She will be sadly missed.

Mrs. Kant is survived by her three sons: Willi (Esther) Anderson, IN, Erich (Esther) Knoxville, TN, and Werner (Karin) Franksville, WI; nine grandchildren: Christopher (Rachel) Kant, Jennifer (David) Durica, Stefanie (Stewart) Farrell,
