Jack Lee Boone, 83, of Mukwonago WI, died February 14, 2015. Jack Boone, son of James and Augusta Boone, husband of Melly Boone, passed away at his home after a long illness from cancer. He also loved piloting and maintaining his Cessna 172 for 35 years, with many Sunday breakfast flights. Jack will be missed by many friends, from his Racine neighborhood to the East Troy Airport; both friends and family will miss his humor and stories.
