RACINE – James Frederick Thiele, 84, passed away on Thursday, February 5, 2015 at Wheaton Franciscan Health Care- All Saints.

Jim was a lifelong resident of Racine, born on August 9, 1930, the son of the late Antone Heinrich and Florence Helen (Stellberg) Thiele. He proudly served in the United States Army during the Korean Conflict, receiving medals and commendations, including a Purple Heart. Upon his honorable discharge from the Army, Jim earned an Associate Degree in ECT.

He had been employed as an Electronic Tech and Tool & Die Maker with General Motors Corp for twenty-eight years, retiring in 1988.

Jim is survived by three nephews, John Busacca of Noblesville, IN, Paul Busacca of Tampa, FL and Peter Busacca of Sammamish, WA. He is further survived by great nieces, great nephews, other relatives and friends and his neighbor family, including the Larrabee family, the Goebel family and the Sturino family.
