RACINE - John P. Blickle, 86, passed away on Sunday, January 17, 2016 at Aurora St. Luke's Hospital in Milwaukee. He was born in Racine on November 24, 1929, the son of the late Ernest and Lena (nee: Buder) Blickle. John was a 1947 graduate of Wm. Horlick High School. He continued his education in Whitewater, receiving his Bachelor's Degree in Education in 1954. He later earned his Master's Degree in Administration. During that time John also served in the United States Navy Reserves from 1951 until his discharge in 1953. On November 26, 1954, he was united in marriage to Mary Ann Sweeti in Menomonie, MI. John was a member of Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church Caledonia. He had been employed with Racine Unified School District for 30 years, retiring as a Principal of Wind Point School. John loved the outdoors, especially at his cabin up north where he enjoyed hunting and fishing.

Surviving are his wife of 61 years, Mary Ann and their children, Jayn (Robert) Bowers and John (Barbara) Blickle; grandchildren, Randy (Jaime) Nelson and Mary Ann Blickle and two great grandchildren, Isabella and Nikolai Nelson. He is further survived by a brother, Fred Blickle, nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends.
