Kurt Brian Jacobson was born on September 21, 1963 to Emogene and Eugene Jacobson. He was born at St. Lukes in Racine, WI at 12:03am. He shared his birthday with his Uncle Herb, who passed away Oct. 1978, and later his niece Mariah Evans. He was the youngest of 3 kids and was a welcome comical addition to the family.

Kurt attended Giese Elementary, Starbuck Jr. high, and Washington Park High School. At Giese, he participated in the Racine Optimist club through the YMCA. While being a part of the Racine Optimist club he enjoyed basketball, baseball and football. In Starbuck, he was on the gymnastics team, the bowling team, and the Spartan football team. During his time at Starbuck, the Spartans became city champions. At Park he was part of the Kipi yearbook staff and graduated in 1981.

After school he worked at Sambo's restaurant while attending Gateway Technical College. He graduated with a Computer Support Technician diploma then was hired into Ameritec phone company, now AT&T, in 1984. He worked for Ward Construction for a time. For the past 15 years he has worked for USIC.

It was a couple years later that he met the love of his life, Joan Klimowitz. They ran away to get married in New Orleans on April 29, 1993. She preceded him in death January 2015.

During his life Kurt enjoyed woodworking, photography, motorcycles, camping, fishing, the Green Bay Packers, dancing (especially tap) and spending time

with his family. He is survived by his parents, Eugene and Emogene (Kvigne) Jacobson; his brother Scott and wife Elissa Jacobson; and his sister Dawn Evans. He was also an amazing uncle to Scott's 2 kids, Sara (Jason) Skipper; and Eric Jacobson; and Dawn's 6 kids, Keosha (1981-1999) and Andreas Oliver; Tiara, Mariah, Michaela and Arrianna Evans.
