Lisa Mary (nee: Mueller) Bell was born December 8, 1953 and adopted by Elizabeth and William Mueller.

She graduated from St. Catherine's Catholic High School in 1971. Lisa was united in marriage to James L. Bell on September 6, 1986 at First United Methodist Church in Racine.

Lisa started her working career at Racine Medical Clinic. She rode her bike from home for four miles on 16th street to get to work. Lisa was in charge of patient information, and handled the conversion from paper to digital which took place at night over the course of many months. Upon assumed completion of the task, a coworker accidentally hit the delete button and became (understandably) hysterical, to which Lisa calmly replied, "Well - let's start over."

After her tenure at RMC, she found herself in need of more challenging work, and so she started work as a temp for Northwestern Mutual, along with several prestigious banks and law offices in Milwaukee.

Lisa was brought up in a musical environment, as her mother was a professional violinist. Lisa taught piano for many years. Seeking improvement, she began attending the Milwaukee Conservatory of Music where she received lessons from the famed pianist Martha Artis.

Lisa's work evolved into politics, having done canvassing door to door with her father when she was quite young. She was chairman of the Racine GOP for many years and became Vice Chairman of the 1st District until the end of her

career.
