RACINE – Lola Jean Geschke, 78, passed away on Tuesday, February 7, 2017.

She was born in Racine on November 9, 1938, the daughter of the late Emery and Lillian (nee: Hobbs) Christensen. Lola was a 1956 graduate of Washington Park High School and furthered her education at MT Senario College Milwaukee with a degree as a Medical Assistant.

Lola was united in marriage to Marvin Geschke in Racine on March 23, 1957. She was employed at Southern Wisconsin Center as a Nurses Aide and Supervisor retiring in 1996 after more than 30 years of service.

Lola is survived by her children, Annalisa Geschke-Papadopoulos of Racine, Mary (Bob) Horn of Racine, and Todd (Ursula) Geschke of Lake Villa, IL; five grandchildren and six great grandchildren.
