Loretta Marguerite (nee: Peters) Brown, 87, passed away on Wednesday September 10, 2025 surrounded by her family and enveloped in their love. 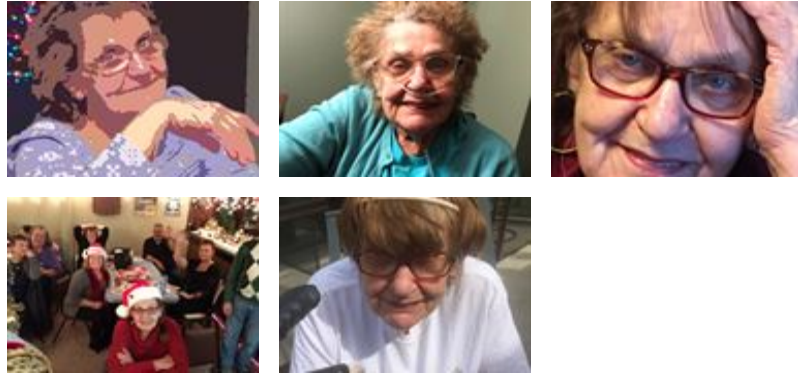

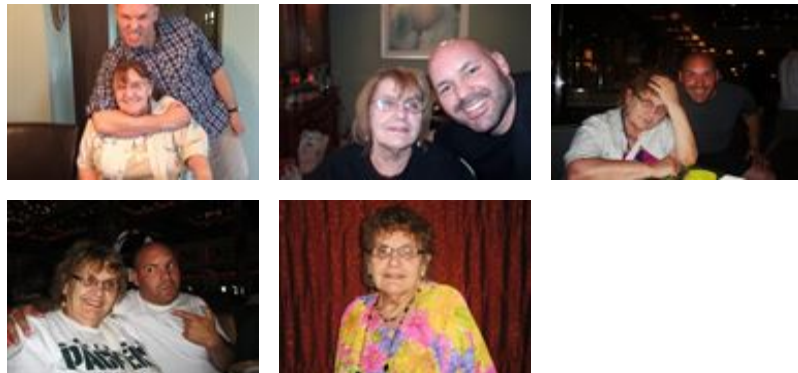
