RACINE - Marvin Fredrick Edmond Fennigkoh, 81, passed away on Saturday, October 31, 2015 at The Villa at Lincoln Park. He was born in LaCrosse on December 24, 1933, the son of the late Harry and Adeline (nee: Lusk) Fennigkoh.

Marvin was a 1953 graduate of Washington Park High School. Marvin enlisted in the United States Navy in 1954 at Great Lakes Naval Training Center. He served during the Korean War and was honorably discharged in 1957 with a rank of E-5. On August 16, 1958 he was united in marriage to Jean Stewart. Marvin was a Patrolman for the Racine Police Department for 31 years. He was a member of City of Racine 20 Year Club, VFW Post 1391, Navy Club Ship 60, American Legion Post and Racine Moose Lodge 437. Marvin was active with the Boy Scouts, enjoyed bowling and was an avid fisherman.

Marvin is survived by his wife of 57 years, Jean, sons, Bruce (Andrea Johnston) Fennigkoh, Michael Fennigkoh and daughter, Kimberly Fennigkoh and one brother, Larry Fennigkoh (Jane Wellenstein) He is further survived by other relatives and many friends.
