Mary was born in Morgansville, West Virginia on April 13, 1923 the daughter of the late Steven B. and Josephine (nee: Pope) Stutler. After graduating from high school, Mary worked as a secretary for the FBI in Washington D.C. Upon moving to San Antonio, Texas in 1970 she became a fashion coordinator for Menger Smart Shop where she worked for 30 years, retiring at the age of 76. Mary was a lifelong member of the Order of the Eastern Star in West Virginia where she grew up.

On October 8, 1944 she was united in marriage to James R. Frame in Scotland County, North Carolina.
