Miguel proudly served his country as a Sargeant in the United States Marines during Vietnam and GITMO. During his 7 years of service, Miguel was awarded National Defense Service Medal, Marine Good Conduct Medal, Vietnam Campaign Medal, Vietnam Service Medal, Combat Action Medal, Presidential Unit Citation, Vietnam Cross of Gallantry with Oak Cluster, Meritorious Unit Commendation Ribbon, Navy & Marine Overseas Service Award, and USN Sea Service Deployment Ribbon. After serving in the Marine Corps., Miguel continued to serve his community with a career in law enforcement in Dallas, Texas, and healthcare in Racine, Wisconsin.

Miguel participated in multiple 4th of July events including a World War II veteran's parade float with his dad as well as a motorcycle precession. 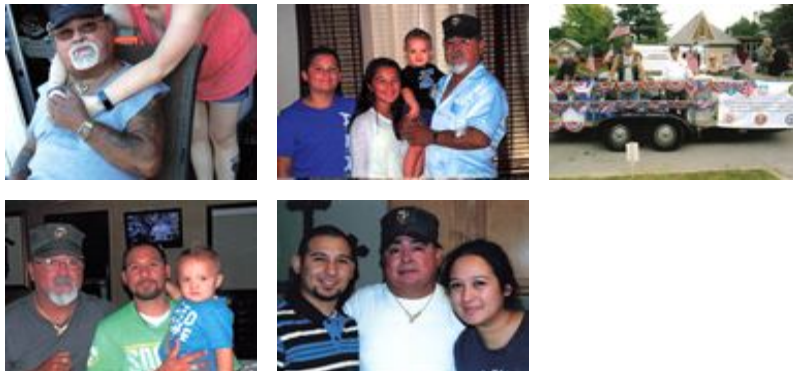
