The family would like to express their sincere appreciation to Jennifer Meekma for the loving care she provided during the last years of Nancy's life.

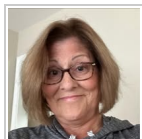

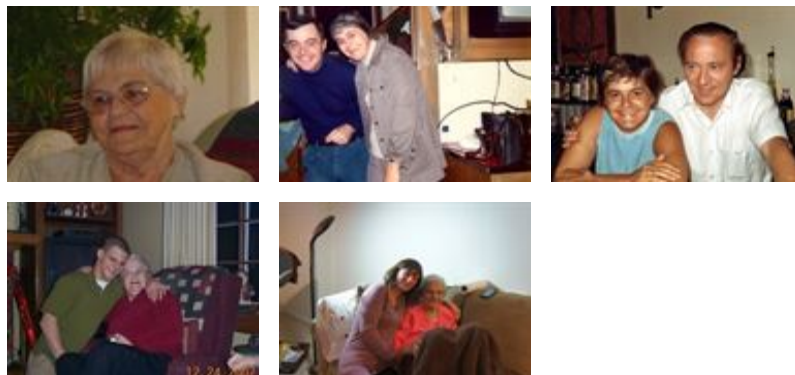
