



## Peter James Bartzen M.D.

September 29, 1952 - April 9, 2026

Dr. Peter James Bartzen, 73, of Racine, Wisconsin died April 9, 2026. Beloved husband, father, grandfather, doctor, brother, uncle and friend, he will be terribly missed by all who had the pleasure to know him. Born September 29, 1952 in Milwaukee, WI, Peter went on to study at the University of Notre Dame - BA, Class of 1974 and then at the University of Minnesota - MD, Class of 1979. Peter worked as a dedicated General & Vascular Surgeon in southeast Wisconsin. Retiring in October of 2020 at the age of 68 after 42 years of training and clinical practice, Peter went on to devote himself to enjoying his growing family. He traveled across the globe to spend time with his 11 grandchildren and, when he could, found time to golf, study history, ski, hunt, and ride bikes with his wife, Angela. His most precious days were spent at his lake house, surrounded by his family, patiently teaching his grandchildren to fish, captaining the boat and lifeguarding as they played and swam. Peter was a beautiful skier and golfer who enjoyed perfecting his craft in defiance of less-than-cooperative knees. Peter & Angela celebrated 50 years of marriage on July 12, 2025, and he described meeting the love of his life at the age of 20 as one of his greatest accomplishments.

He is survived by his wife of 50 years, Angela, his children, Nicholas (Rachael) Bartzen, Elena Bartzen, Elise (Daniel) O'Brien, Natalie (Joel) Sharbrough and 11 grandchildren - Marco, Jane, Vivian, Wesley, Anna, Emilia, Peter, Ellis, Heidi, Bobby and Ada.

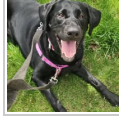
