CALEDONIA - Nellie Kingsfield, 92, passed away peacefully on Sunday, April 4, 2021, at her residence, surrounded by her family.

She was born on August 17, 1928 to the late Charles and Esther (nee:Reyenga) Kuiper. Nellie was a 1942 graduate of Racine Christian School. On October 17, 1947, she married her grade school sweetheart, Harry Kingsfield, at the Racine Christian Reformed Church. They were married for 68 years and farmed together until retirement. She also cleaned numerous homes and offices for many years. She loved her Lord, and was a lifelong member of Racine Christian Reformed Church. Nellie enjoyed visits from family and friends, socializing, attending family get-togethers, and sporting events. She also was a member of the Caledonia Historical Society. Nellie loved baking and was well known for her wonderful pies, giving her the nickname the "pie lady".

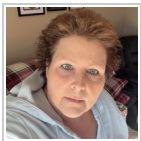

“ Our heartfelt sympathies go out to Peggy, Sandy, Judy and their families.

I have many memories of Nellie growing up on Hwy 38. As a neighbor to the Kingsfield family for many years and my father and grandfather before me, I used to love going there. My dad, Bill, would often work with Harry, after working his day job. I would beg him to let me join him. Many years later, I would help on the Kingsfield farm, particularly during planting and harvest season. And of course, baling straw in the heat of summer.

Imagine if you will, this same woman who always wore her Sunday best to church, dressed in work pants & shirt with a handkerchief holding her hair back, working to help her husband. This is the same lady that my wife would frequently run into shopping at Kohls. I recall her driving the work truck across the field delivering lunch or dinner during those busy seasons. She would drive the grain truck as well. You could hear her pull out of the driveway, turn left and accelerate down the hill and up the hill by the Otto home – gears clashing and the transaxle grinding. Nellie was just as comfortable driving a farm tractor, International/Farmall of course, including the tractor for baling straw. Many years later she would still mention the time I fell off the wagon stacking bales with Harry when she drove over a hole in the field and I broke my wrist.

I wasn't until many years later that I learned we were related. I believe Nellie and my grandfather, Richard (also known as Dick) were cousins. Nellie shared whom she was named after. It was my great-grandmother Pietje Kuiper-DeVries otherwise known as Nellie.

Many memories trickle back to those days living on Hwy 38. The wild cats and kittens that Nellie kept fed, including one with a short, kinked tail from taking on a grain augers. Timber, the German shepherd who never barked when you arrived but barked like crazy when you left. Riding with Peggy, Sandy, and Judy to Sunday

School and even before that, they babysat my sister and I.

Our heartfelt sympathies to the family. Nellie is reunited with Harry and arrived there on Easter to see her Savior face to face.
