Bob was united in marriage to Joan Kranz on August 12, 1961 at St. John's Nepomuk in Racine.

Bob proudly served in the United State Army from 1948 until 1968. He fought in the Korean Conflict. Robert was stationed in Germany, Korea and Addis Ababa, (capital city) Ethiopia, Denver and Durango, CO, Freeport, and Chicago, IL, and Camp Atterbury, IN.

After his army retirement, he was employed at Sears and Turnstyle in Racine and as an Industrial Sales Representative at Crane & Son in Waukesha.
