Robert Wayne Brown, 66, passed away on Wednesday, May 9, 2018 at his residence.

He was born in Peekskill, New York on October 15, 1951, the son of the late Oscar W. and Helen (nee: Edick) Brown. On May 19, 1973, Robert was united in marriage to Lillian F. Taylor in Racine. He was employed with Canadian Pacific Railroad, retiring after 39 years.

Robert was a member of North Pointe United Methodist Church, National Railroad Historical Society, and Milwaukee Railroad Historical Society. He enjoyed photography, and was a rail fan. Robert considered himself an amateur historian.

Surviving are his wife, Lillian Brown; daughters, Melissa Ellen Brown of Anderson, CA, and Elinor Marie (Eric John) Offerdahl of Racine. He is further survived by other relatives and friends.

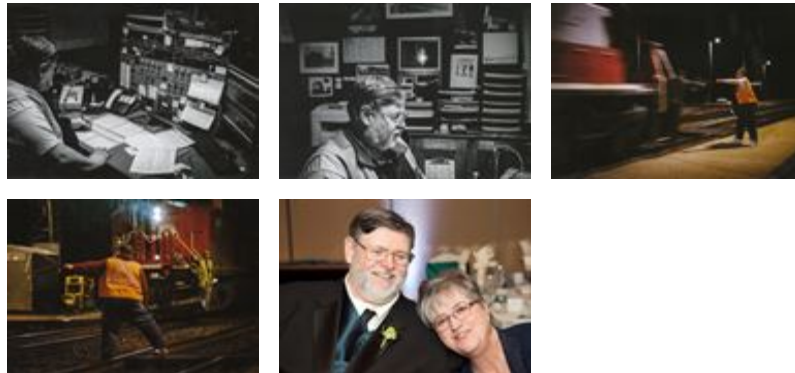
