RACINE - Robert 'Bob' Corman, 87, passed away on Friday, August 20, 2010 at Wheaton Franciscan Healthcare - All Saints. He was born on February 7, 1923 in Wilmor, KY, the son of the late Ernest and Matilda (nee: Alcorn) Corman. Robert proudly served in the United States Army from 1943 to 1945. Receiving the Asiatic-Pacific Theatre Ribbon with two bronze stars, Philippine Liberation Ribbon with one bronze star, Good Conduct Medal and the Victory Medal.

On June 11, 1949, he was united in marriage to Dorothy Harmel at Atonement Lutheran Church, where he was a lifelong member. Bob built one of his own homes and enjoyed woodworking, building dollhouses and furniture. He also enjoyed programming and operating his electronic knitting machine, producing hats and scarves for his church and other charitable organizations. Robert always looked forward to fishing when he was at his home in northern Wisconsin.
