He was born in Hamtramck, MI on August 3, 1961, the son of Robert J. and Mabel (nee: Sobolewski) Maciejewski. Bob was a graduate of St. Ladislaus High School in Hamtramck. He earned his Bachelor's Degree in Criminal Justice from Wayne State University in Detroit, MI, then was commissioned as an Officer in the United States Army. On June 22, 1985, he was united in marriage to Jamie Jamison in Clarksville, TN. Robert worked for the Racine Police Department for 22 years, retiring in 2012 as Sergeant.

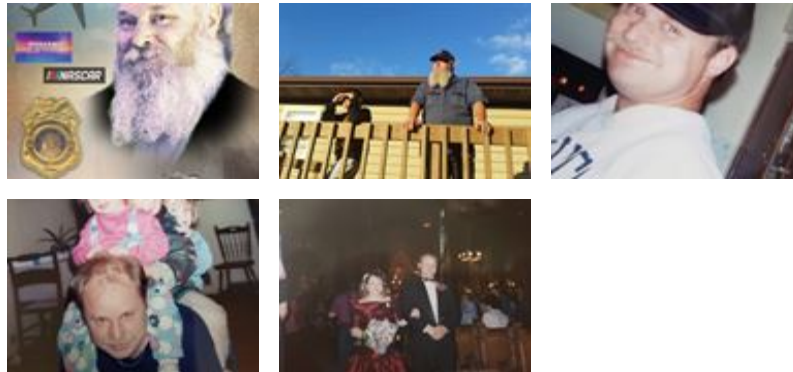
