RACINE - Ronald Lyle Baer, 77, passed away on Monday, May 24, 2021. He was born in Bloomington, Illinois on February 22, 1944, the son of the late Lyle and Anna (nee: Williams) Baer. On July 12, 1968, Ron was united in marriage to Carol Barina. They later had a church ceremony on October 28, 1977. Ron served in the United States Army during Vietnam. He was a firefighter for the city of Racine for 29 years, retiring in 1999.

Ron loved his family and caring for his grandchildren. He enjoyed playing cards, especially Texas Hold 'Em, golfing, going camping, vacationing in Hawaii, sitting outdoors and enjoying nature, and watching TV and movies with Carol.

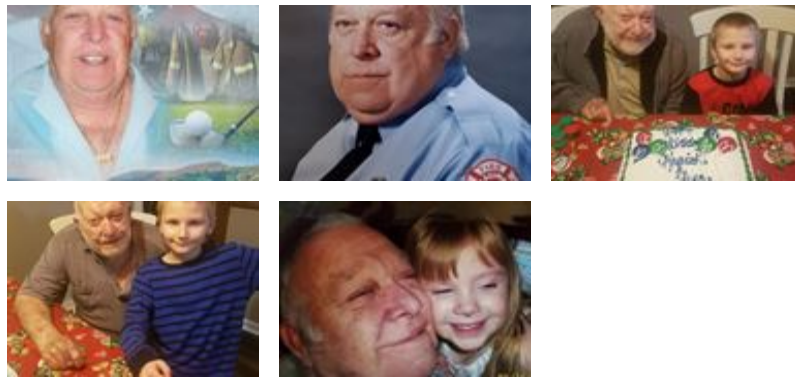

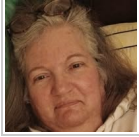
