RACINE – Rosemary Ann (nee: Madden) McNally, 91, passed away on Monday, January 16, 2012 at Becker Shoop Center. After their retirement they enjoyed trips to Ireland and many years of traveling, throughout the United States. She also was a member of the Women’s Club, PBX Club, Bridge Club and the Black Garter Club. Rosemary enjoyed being with family, loved to entertain and especially having fun with her friends.

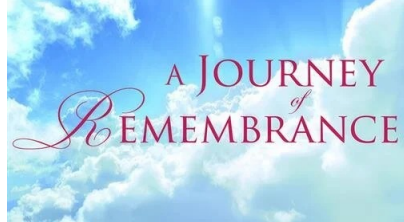
