RACINE – Ruth Meta Elizabeth (nee: Saas) Hagert, 98 went home to be with our lord on Friday, June 10, 2016.

She was born in Racine on February 14, 1918, the daughter of the late Otto R. and Caroline C. (nee: Eichman) Saas. After graduation, Ruth attended Business College and was employed as a Secretary to Mr. Toohey of Keefe & Co. Home Owners Loan. Ruth proudly served in the United States Navy, enlisting on September 23, 1943. During her service she continued her schooling in USNTS Bronx, New York and served the remainder of her time with Bureau Personnel Annex in Arlington, VA. Ruth was honorably discharged as Yeoman Second Class on February 9, 1946. On September 21, 1946, in Racine, Ruth was united in marriage to Marcus Winston Hagert Sr. Her working career continued as secretary for Racine Tool and Machine, now known as Racine Hydraulics. Ruth was a member of Racine Bible Church. Ruth is survived by her daughter, Kathleen Hagert of Racine; son, Marcus W.
