RACINE - Sandra 'Sandy' L. Ager, 68, was born on March 7, 1946 in Racine, WI. The daughter of Capt. Kenneth and Beverly (Morgenson) Merrill, Sandy traveled the country and the world as an Air Force brat, her own words, but made her way back to Racine where she lived until her passing on Friday January 30, 2015. She was a member of the Washington Park High School class of 1964.
