Sally was born in Racine on July 2, 1930, the daughter of the late Charles J. and Gertrude (nee: Lahr) Haumersen.

On August 19, 1967, Sally was united in marriage to Harold Hay. Harold preceded her in death exactly three months earlier on February 16, 2017.

Sally was a graduate of Washington Park High School "Class of 1948." She became a Registered Nurse after graduating from West Suburban Hospital School of Nursing in Oak Park, IL, in 1953 and also graduated in 1955 from Wheaton College. For over 25 years of her professional career Sally was Dr. James J.G. Petersen's nurse and also a nurse at Racine's local hospitals. She was a longtime and faithful member of Racine Bible Church. Sally was very involved with various ministries within the church: Women's Ministry coordinator, Sunday school teacher, youth group assistant, missionary committee and Phoebe member.
