CALEDONIA – Scott Allan Yohn, 72, passed away on Wednesday, February 11, 2026, at Froedtert South Hospital in Pleasant Prairie, surrounded by his loving family.

He was born on October 24, 1953, to Gilbert and Willene (née Rice) Yohn. Scott was united in marriage to Trudy Durben on September 13, 1975, and they recently celebrated 50 years of marriage.

Scott dedicated much of his working life to manufacturing, spending 25 years at Letsch Manufacturing and 15 years at Modine Manufacturing as a Fabricating Engineer. After retiring, he fulfilled a longtime dream by purchasing and operating the Country Pump Bar in Caledonia with his wife, Trudy, which they proudly owned for the past 15 years.

Scott's greatest joy was spending time with his wife, Trudy, and their two dogs, Rozy May and Foxy Lady, at their cabin in Fox Lake, Wisconsin. He loved taking quiet rides on his pontoon and making memories with his grandchildren by the lake. He treasured his time with his daughters, Heather and Niki, and loved every opportunity to laugh with them, talk with them, and simply be their proud dad. Scott had many friends who will remember him for his warm smile and his ability to make everyone feel like they truly mattered. He was an avid NASCAR fan and racing enthusiast, a passion he was proud to share with his son, Jason. The Country Pump was more than a business to Scott—it was a family, and he was especially grateful for the wonderful bartenders and friends who meant so much to him.

Scott is survived by his three children: Jason (Amberlyn) Yohn, Nicole (Niki) Buschke, and Heather Yohn; and his grandchildren: Hunter (Alex) Beal, Scott Yohn, Jordan Beal, Nicholas Yohn, Cameron Yohn, Alyssa Gilliam, Ethan Buschke, Paige Buschke, and Tyler Yohn.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Gilbert and Willene Yohn, and his beloved grandson, Jordan Beal.
