Shawn was born in Rockford, IL, December 13, 1969. He is the son of Mary Kay (Malmberg) Kanyuh and Robert Boyer.

Shawn worked at Hansen Storage, UTI, Diversy, UNFI and other places of business.

Some absolutely wonderful traits about Shawn are that he was kind, giving and helped others whenever he could. He loved children, the very old and all in between. He loved his papa (maternal grandfather) dearly. He was such an animal lover, dogs, dolphins and ferrets (he has had at least six) being his favorites. He really wanted to train service dogs and had started checking into it. Shawn was an old soul. He was very patriotic and would put 50 flags out on the lawn every patriotic holiday. He always shook the hand of a veteran and told that person how proud he was of him/her. He was on the diving team in high school and a great artist which led him to attend The Art Institute of Fort Lauderdale, FL. Shawn was a jack of all trades from refinishing his entire basement to being a wonderful cook, fettuccine alfredo was one his specialties. He loved the outdoors, from doing the yard work (riding his lawnmower) to many nights sitting outside at Ben and Lora's with his 'other people' in front of a fire. He loved the block parties, Packer parties, Halloween parties, 4th of July parties and more and always helped Ben and others set them up. He loved to decorate for holidays especially Halloween and Christmas. It is unbelievable how he could wrap a Christmas or birthday gift. Music (most genres) was a big part of his life. He was very much into astronomy. He studied and spoke about it often with Alec and has a large telescope that he would gaze at

the stars and planets with. Shawn always sewed Alec's special patches on his clothes and he was always sewing up stuffed animal toys for Goldee that she had accidentally torn.

His favorite 'go to' people for listening and talking for hours were Cale, Bonnie, Sandor (his best friend since high school), Ben, Lora, Carrie, Dave, Dianne, Jim, Bruce, Connie H., and, of course, Connie B.

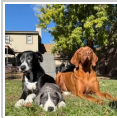
