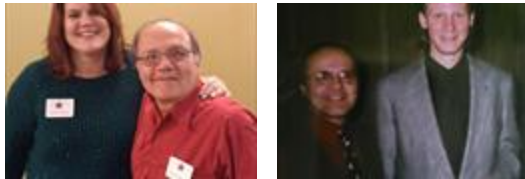
His laugh was infectious and once he got started, he couldn't stop laughing which made us laugh all the harder too.

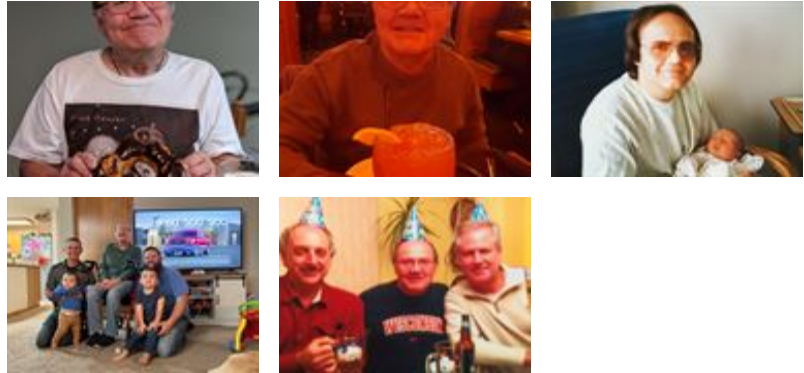
