Thomas George Hynes, 69, passed away on Friday, January 31, 2025, at Ascension All Saints, Racine. He was born in Algona, Iowa on August 19, 1955, the son of Joseph Edward and Mary Jane (nee: Klein) Hynes.

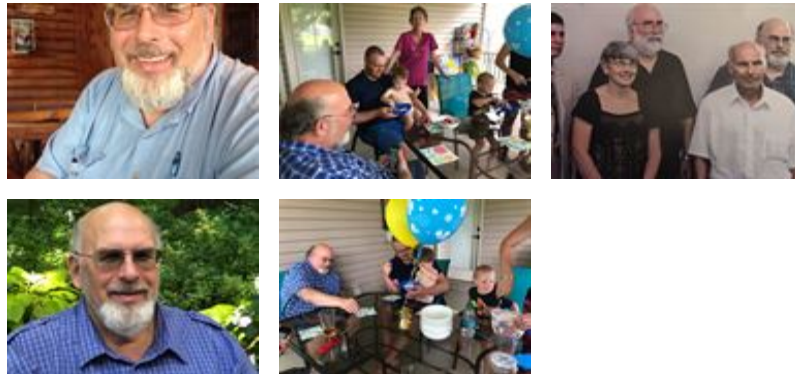
