Thomas S. Just, 91, passed away on Tuesday, December 31, 2024 at the Waters of Oak Creek with his family at his side.

Tom was born on September 15, 1933 to Joseph and Anna (nee: Post) Just. He was united in marriage to Lisa Parnau on April 5, 1986 in Racine.

After graduating from Washington Park High School, Tom later joined the United States Army, serving for two years. Sports were always a part of Tom's life including managing the Racine Lions baseball club and later coaching his sons' basketball teams. He was a proud marathon finisher, natural point guard, and lifetime Chicago Cubs fan. Tom enjoyed raising, training, and showing German Shepherd dogs, and loved listening to jazz music. He had a successful career in manufacturing, but as family always came first for him, he then decided to stay at home to raise their sons. Tom spent many hours volunteering at St. Edward's School with them. He enjoyed family trips taken to different parts of the world, including New Orleans (his favorite city!), Germany, Alaska, Hawaii, Africa, and Iceland.

Tom will be deeply missed by his wife, Lisa Just; sons, Zachary Just (Gabbie Becker) and Alec (Karie) Just; brother, Tim (Kathy) Just; niece, Kim (Michael) Torhorst; and other family members and friends.

He is preceded in death by his parents, Joseph and Anna Just; and daughter, Kelsey Alise Parnau Just.

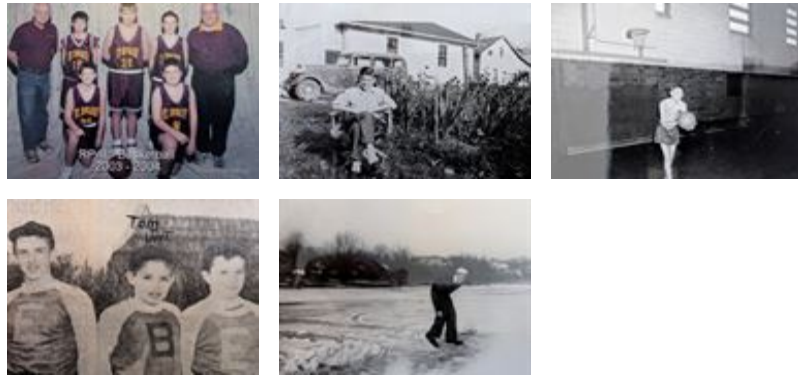

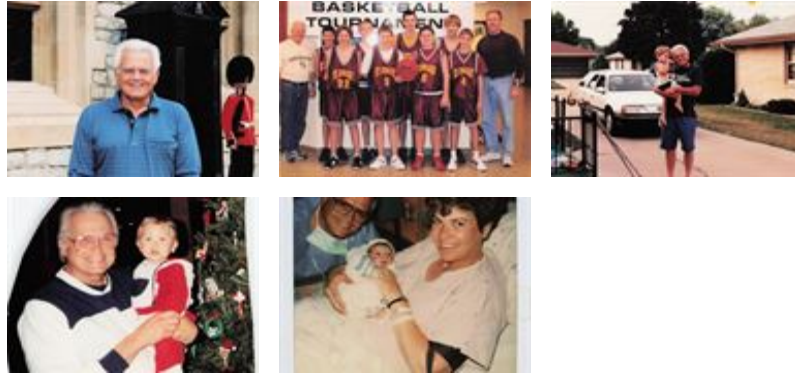
