RACINE-Thomas John Siebert, 86, a lifelong resident of Racine, passed away on Friday, August 14, 2015 at Wisconsin Veterans Home in Dover. Tom was born on October 10, 1929, the son of the late John O. and Ida Siebert. While a student at Washington Park High School, Tom was eager to enlist with the Navy and proudly served on the crews of the USS Edisto and the USS Shenandoah during the Korean Conflict. He always remembered his navy years and mates with particular fondness.

During his military service Tom learned his trade and went on to work as an expert welder for the duration of his professional life. In addition to having operated his own business for several years, employments included E.C. Styberg Engineering, Albert's Tool and Die and J.I. Case from where he retired, greatly enjoying a long and contented retirement.

His last years were happily lived out in Fairchild Hall of the Veteran's Home in Dover where he greatly appreciated the warm and professional care shown him by the nurses, CNA's and Activities and Foods Service staffs. Tom especially held the Social Workers and Dietitians in special affection.

Tom would be glad to be remembered as a man who worked hard, loved and provided for his family, and was an ardent American patriot.

Tom was preceded in death by his three wives, Dolores (nee: Lenzke) Siebert, Margaret (nee: Kellner) Siebert, and Judy (nee: Vance) Siebert, in addition to one sister, Margaret Lessnau.
