



## Thomas Guy Sturino

February 27, 1920 - July 30, 2013

Tom Sturino, 93, of Kenosha, passed away peacefully, Tuesday, July 30, 2013, at the Racine Hospice House.

Born in Kenosha February 27, 1920, he was the son of the late Carmine and Rose (Ricchio) Sturino. A lifelong resident of Kenosha, Tom attended local schools before attending MSOE to pursue an associate degree in welding. As a young man, Tom entered the Civilian Conservation Corps (CCC) and contributed to the rebirth of our Wisconsin forests in the Rhinelander area. On July 27, 1940 Tom married Marguerite Munson. A World War II veteran, he served in the infantry of the United States Army toward the end of the war, seeing action across France, Belgium (where he fought outside of Bastogne at the Battle of the Bulge) and finally outside of Berlin, Germany at the end of the conflict. Tom retired from the Teamsters after thirty years having worked as an over-the-road driver for KAT, and welder for Arco Auto Carriers. He was preceded in death by his parents, his sister Virginia, of Florida and his wife of fifty-five years. He is survived by his three children, Guy of Virginia Beach, Kathleen (Brainard) of San Diego, Marty of Racine, five grandchildren and three great-grand children. A private funeral is being planned.
