I remember laying on the floor with Barb and Laura sewing Barbie clothes. I learned to tell the twins a part, loved visiting Grandma and Grandpa Ganzel next door, Sandy babysat me when I was young as well. I remember thinking Peter was so tall (insert chuckle), and had a crush on her brothers as all Virgies friends had. I loved that that Mrs. Medemdorp had the twins on her birthday and that Virginia Jr's birthday was the first of the year. Mr. and Mrs. Medendorp, raised a beautiful family...not one without flaws, not anyone to replace my family, but a family of love, patience, caring, sharing, even dealing with the chubby girl from down the block. :)

After I got married, prematurely and had my daughter, I wanted to visit Mrs. Medendorp. Heather and I spent an hour or so with Mrs. M. I was scared and excited at the same time. She was so kind....and loving. The next time I saw her was a Pete's funeral (23 years later). It brings tears to my eyes that she may have never realized just how important her influence on the family contributed to my growth in life and in faith! I share this with you, because there is NO DOUBT, that God placed this remarkable family in my life to plant the seeds enriching the faith of a child, making the roots deep

*enough for the one day my family and I would the Lord. I love each of you so much. I am thrilled that your Mom is at the right hand of the Lord and got to hug Pete again. 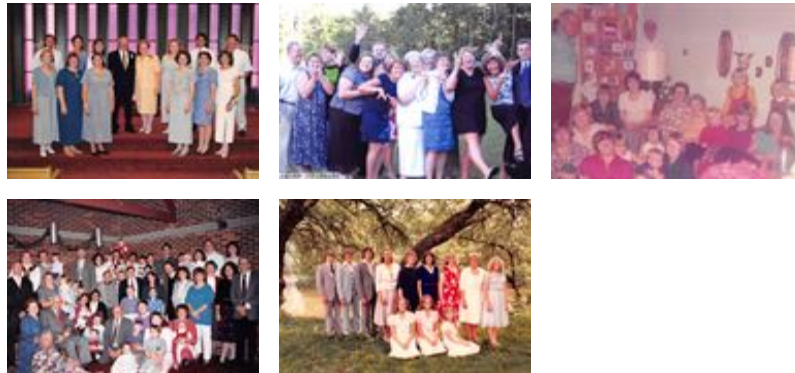
